PARK REGULATIONS

§101. Hours of Operation.

Parks, playgrounds and recreation areas of the Borough shall be open between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 10:30 p.m., prevailing time, unless otherwise approved by the Borough.

§102. Prohibited Acts.

The following acts, uses and conduct in parks, playgrounds, recreation areas and municipal parking lots of the Borough are prohibited:

- A. Possession or use of alcoholic beverages.
- B. Use of off-road motorcycles, minibikes, go-carts, snowmobiles and other nonlicensed motorized vehicles.
- C. Operating or parking of any motor vehicle on the grass or other nonmacadamized area.
- D. Possession of or allowing animals onto the parks, playgrounds or recreation areas, except for seeing eye dogs or other special exceptions approved by the Borough in advance.
- E. The construction or use of fire except in a barbecue grill or other equipment designed for that purpose.
- F. To injure, deface, remove, cut or damage any tree, plant, turf, building, structure, equipment, supplies or other property.
- G. To possess or discharge any firearm, bow and arrows, air or spring rifles, slings, slingshots or any other weapon.
- H. To possess or use any water gun or similar device within the Fun Fort playground area.
- I. To direct the flow of a water gun or similar device at another person or animal.

- J. To possess or use any skateboard, roller skates or in-line skates, except for the street hockey rink at the Poplar Street park and the roller/skateboard court.
- K. To set up any booth, table or stand, mobile or otherwise, for the sale of any articles, whatsoever, without the permission of the Borough.
- L. To ride or operate a bicycle, scooter or other nonmotorized vehicle in an unsafe or reckless manner.
- M. No driving golf balls nor the practicing of golf.
- N. No person shall use profane language, conduct themselves in any lewd, immoral or commonly objectionable manner within the park.

§103. Penalties.

Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate any provision of this Part shall be, upon conviction thereof, sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$25 nor more \$600 plus costs and, in default of payment of said fine and costs, to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 30 days.
