Reporting a Street Light Outage

While Elizabethtown Borough pays the monthly utility costs for streetlights, PPL owns and is responsible for repairs to (or replacement of) malfunctioning streetlights.

You can contact PPL, Inc. directly at 1-800-DIAL-PPL (1-800-342-5775) to report an outage.



In order to provide PPL with the information they need to send out their service staff to the proper location, you should be prepared to provide the unique pole number from the street light pole. Each pole with a street light should have a small metal placard located at eye level on the pole containing a two-line PPL pole number. If you have any questions, please reach out to the Borough 717-367-1700.

MS4 Tip:

Autumn is here! With the season, new projects in the yard arrive with the cooler weather. Please be mindful of how you dispose of leaves and yard waste. Leaves dumped into stormwater basins can cause an accumulation of harmful nutrients, which can negatively impact our local stream system. Leaves that are left in the street can easily enter the stormwater system causing blockages or make their way into streams. Also, be mindful of the amount of fertilizer being used when preparing your lawn for the winter months. Please do not use fertilizers immediately before a rainstorm and do not apply any more than needed.

Refuse and Recycling Reminders

- Place items for weekly curbside collection out the night before the scheduled collection, this includes yard waste and oversized items.
- Collection items should not be lined up on the driveway, the hauler will not collect items from a driveway.
- For trash collection you may use two containers or bags no larger than 32-gallons. Containers and bags should weigh no more than 30 pounds. Additional containers or bags require an extra trash tag that you can purchase at the Borough Office or at local convenience and grocery stores. As set by Resolution 2022-23, beginning January 1, 2023, the cost of an Extra Service Trash Tag will increase to \$3.00 per tag.
- For recycling collection you may use multiple containers. The container(s) should be 32-gallons or less in size, weigh no more than 30 pounds, and must have a recycling symbol sticker adhered to it. The Borough Office supplies stickers free of charge!
- Recyclable material is limited to the "Big 4" (corrugated cardboard, plastic bottles and jugs with necks, metal food and beverage cans and glass jars and bottles).
 Rinse all items thoroughly to remove contaminants prior to placing in the recycling container. Please DO NOT place plastic bags in the recycling container.

Curbside Collection: Yard Waste & Leaves



Yard waste should be placed in marked containers and/or Kraft Bags. Waste should be placed same day as trash. As a reminder, grass clippings are not yard waste and should not be placed curbside for pickup.
