2022 Budget & Rate Information

At their public meetings in December, Elizabethtown Borough Council finalized the budget for Fiscal Year 2022. The Borough will provide more detailed budget information in a forthcoming Borough Bulletin; however, below are important updates for the community:

- Adopted Ordinance #1002 levying a tax, for general Borough purposes, on all real estate within the Borough subject to taxation at a rate of 5.1 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation. This represents a 0.5 mill increase over last years rate (of 4.6 mills).
- To cover increasing disposal costs, the Refuse and Recycling rate will increase to \$232.00 for 2022 (or \$58.00 per quarter). The increase will be reflected in utility bills received in early January 2022.
- To plan for needed infrastructure improvements, the Borough increased Sanitary Sewer Rates beginning in 2022. The Residential Rate for each single-family dwelling unit and each apartment unit will increase to \$420.00 for 2022 (or \$105.00 per quarter). Commercial units and mixed usage units will increase to \$0.0092 per gallon per quarter or a minimum of \$105.00/quarter. The rate increase will be reflected in utility bills received in April 2022.

What Goes in the Recycle Bin?



- Corrugated Cardboard: This includes material consisting of fluted corrugated sheet, such as shipping and packing boxes.
- Plastic Bottles and Jugs: This includes plastic bottles, jars, jugs and anything else with a neck. Throw away the lids and rinse out any residue.



- Metal Food and Beverage Cans: This includes all food and beverage cans made from aluminum or steel. Throw away the lids and rinse out any residue.
- Glass Jars and Bottles: This includes clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars. Throw away the lids and rinse out any residue.
