

Resolution No. 2018-6

BOROUGH OF ELIZABETHTOWN LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF ELIZABETHTOWN ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY PARKING RESTRICTION ON THE NORTH AND SOUTH SIDE OF EAST WILLOW STREET DUE TO THE CONSTRUCTION AND BRIDGE REPAIR THAT WILL OCCUR ON NORTH MARKET STREET.

WHEREAS, Borough Council is granted the authority to create temporary parking restrictions while construction work is underway pursuant to Chapter 15 of the Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the construction and bridge repair on North Market Street will close a portion of North Market Street and require vehicular traffic to be detoured;

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has analyzed the impact on existing streets and has recommended a temporary parking restriction on both the North and South side of East Willow Street during the construction project;

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended the following a temporary parking restriction on East Willow Street:


There shall be no parking on the North or South curb of East Willow Street, extending from the corner of East Willow Street and Market Street through the corner of East Willow Street and Cherry Alley. This parking restriction will allow for an appropriate turning radius for any vehicle that is forced to turn onto East Willow Street as a detour around the location of the construction and also facilitate for the efficient movement of emergency vehicles around the construction area.

WHEREAS, the temporary parking restriction, on East Willow Street, is recommended to be in place for 90 days. Specifically, it would begin June 1, 2018 and conclude September 1, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Elizabethtown approves the temporary parking restriction on East Willow Street as recommended by the Chief of Police, and discussed at a regularly scheduled meeting of Borough Council.
