A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF ELIZABETHTOWN INSTITUTING TEMPORARY PARKING RESTRICTIONS FOR A PORTION OF SOUTH MOUNT JOY STREET

- WHEREAS, Chapter 15, Section 106 (Experimental Regulations) of the Borough Code of the Borough of Elizabethtown grants Borough Council the authority to institute temporary parking/traffic regulations; and
- WHEREAS, temporary parking/traffic regulations under the Experimental Regulation Ordinance referred to in Chapter 15, Section 106, are limited to 90 days; and
- WHEREAS, the existing vehicle cartway on the section of South Mount Joy Street between Ridge Road and Groff Avenue will be narrowed to construct pedestrian facilities on this street; and
- WHEREAS, to facilitate for adequate travel lanes and pedestrian facilities, parking will be restricted on one side of the street.
- WHEREAS, creation of these temporary parking restrictions will apply to the west side of South Mount Joy Street between Ridge Road and Groff Avenue; and
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elizabethtown, Lancaster County, that the following temporary parking/traffic restrictions take effect July 1, 2019 for a 90-day period expiring September 28, 2019:
 - No parking on the west side of South Mount Joy Street between Ridge Road and Groff Avenue.
