BOROUGH OF ELIZABETHTOWN LANCASTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

RESOLUTION 2022-30 OF THE COUNCIL OF ELIZABETHTOWN BOROUGH, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania (hereinafter "the Borough").

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act," as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of **Pennsylvania Code**, requires the municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality, and

WHEREAS, the Borough has prepared a Act 537 Official Sewage Facilities Plan Special Study which provides for sewage facilities in a portion of the Borough of Elizabethtown, and

WHEREAS, the alternative of choice to be implemented is the replacement of the Radio Road Interceptor existing sewer mains, manholes, and lateral connections from Radio Road to the Conoy Interceptor in the Borough of Elizabethtown, for which the key implementation activities/dates are described in the Facilities Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Borough finds that the Facilities Plan described above conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Borough of Elizabethtown hereby adopt and submit to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the "Official Plan" of the Borough, the above referenced Facilities Plan. The Borough hereby assures the Department of the complete and timely implementation of the said plan as required by law. (Section 5, Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act as amended).
