ELIZABETHTOWN BOROUGH COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING September 17, 2015 Minutes

The regular meeting of Elizabethtown Borough Council was held on Thursday, September 17, 2015 at 7:00 p.m. at the Borough Office. Present were Councilmembers Phil Clark, J. Marc Hershey, Jeff McCloud, Tom Shaud, Dr. C. Dale Treese, and J. Neil Ketchum, Jr. Also present were Borough Manager Roni Ryan, Assistant Borough Manager Cindy Foster, Planning and Zoning Director Rodney Horton, Police Chief Jack Mentzer, and Mayor Chuck Mummert.

Public Comment

1. **Russell Obenstine, 133 Cliff Lane,** stated he has noticed a heroin problem in his neighborhood and that while the response from the Elizabethtown Police Department has been great, community awareness/involvement is key. McCloud responded that Elizabethtown Communities that Care is aware of the problem and is working to address it.

Reports

- 1. The Financial Report was unanimously approved after a motion by Hershey, second by McCloud.
- 2. The Code Enforcement Report was provided as an informational item.
- 3. The Fire Company responded to 69 calls during the month of August, 26 of which were in the Borough, with an average response time of 4 minutes 14 seconds. Hershey reported the fourth annual golf tournament held September 11th was a success. The event drew 132 golfers, 52 sponsors, and generated over \$10,000 in income.
- 4. Northwest EMS had no report.

Old Business

1. <u>Chamber of Commerce Update</u>—Ramon Escudero, Executive Director for the Chamber, provided an update on the hiring process for a part-time downtown manager and introduced Rebecca Denlinger who has accepted the position. Denlinger shared a brief overview of her background and her experiences working on community and economic development initiatives with boroughs in Lancaster County. She expressed thanks for the opportunity to focus on downtown Elizabethtown and pledged to report regularly to Council on her progress.

1. Motion by Clark, second by McCloud, to award the contract for Solid Waste and Recyclable Material Collection to Lebanon Farms Disposal for the low bid amount of \$86.88 per unit for the first year of the three-year contract. The following bids were received:
